

**La Salle College 2022-2023**  
**After School Learning Support Grant**  
**Annual Plan**

**Background**

This project aims to provide academic support for students with academic difficulties who have applied for Financial Assistance Schemes for Secondary Students, to improve their academic results in the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education. Old boy tutors are recruited to provide academic support to the target recipients.

**Selection Criteria**

Students meeting two of the following criteria are invited to join the after school learning:

- Students with average score below 40 in the final examination
- Students eligible for financial assistance from the Student Finance Office
- Students taking part in school's sports teams

**Objectives of the programme are as follows:**

- Average score of 50 or above in internal examinations.
- Improving the language proficiencies of students
- Meeting the requirement of Conditional Offers/ Sports Scholarships from universities

The after school learning support programme, with a smaller class size than normal class, provides more interaction between the tutor and students. It provides the opportunity for students to focus on specific fields to cater for their individual differences. 20 students have taken part in the programme last year, and they have also taken part in the enhancement programme provided by the enhancement team. Two old boys tutors will participate in the after school learning support programme (Language tutorial and Mathematics tutorial). The tutorial classes will be conducted during lunch time. Students are required to have 90% attendance.

**Expected expenditure: \$25000**
