Target / Goal	Action	Evaluation
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Average score of 50 or above in internal examinations.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Students are required to attend at least 90% of the tutorial lessons.</li> <li>-Assignments are given out to participants weekly, students are required to hand in during the following session for inspection.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-All students are able to fulfil the attendance requirement.</li> <li>- Online tutorial lessons were held and assignments were marked online from February to May. Most students were able to hand in the materials on time. Face to face lessons were held immediately after school to improve the learning of the student.</li> <li>- Two-third of the student joining the scheme achieved the goal of passing the final examination. However, one-third of the student failed to meet the goal, but their form position improved.</li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Improving the language proficiencies of students</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Assessments and past paper were provided to test the students' abilities in both languages, and to encourage them to practise the knowledge learnt at a regular basis.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For junior form students, reading materials were provided to them to develop a reading habit. Materials related to their specific sports events were provided to make it more sophisticated.</li> <li>80% of the junior form students who failed the final examination had difficulties in English in the final examination which affected other subjects. Students should further improve their reading habit to steadily improve their English.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Meeting the requirement of Conditional Offers/ Sports Scholarships from universities</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>JUPAS admission talk will be provided to students about the information of universities.</li> <li>Talks on Sports scholarship scheme of various universities will be provided to students</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>80% of the participants were able to meet the entrance requirement of the university. Two of the students received and met the conditional sports scholarship requirement of the university.</li> <li>JUPAS admission talks on sports scholarships were held in the first term. Some of the talks were held online due to the pandemic.</li> <li>One of the students scored over 40 points out of his best 7 subjects and was admitted by the department of medicine of the University of Hong Kong.</li> </ul>
